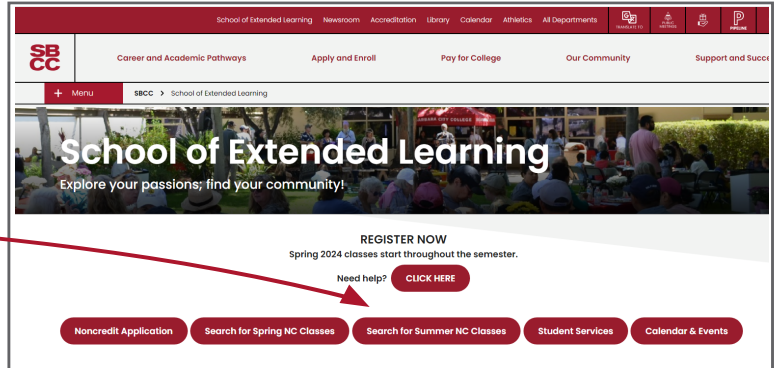


# HOW TO FIND YOUR CLASSES & SCHEDULES

## School of Extended Learning Noncredit Classes

How to view the online schedule and search for classes that interest you.

1. Go to **sel.sbcc.edu**  
Click the red "Search" button labeled with the desired semester.



2. Once the page loads:
  - a. Click on the desired **Term**.
  - b. Click on **Noncredit** or **AHS/GED**.
  - c. Click on the **Select** button and let the screen refresh.
  - d. You can search by subject or any other search criteria if desired.
  - e. Click on the **Search** button to go to the class schedule.

Effective Spring 2024 Registration Period, SBCC has made a slight change to how class sections are listed in the LIVE schedule of classes webpage. To help clarify the differences between 'closed' classes vs 'standby', we are listing the definitions below.

Status: **Open!** Students are eligible to register for the section.  
**Closed!** Students cannot register for this section directly at this time.  
**Standby!** Class section is ready to open upon student demand.  
**Waitlisted!** Class section is full and students are able to add themselves to the waitlist.

Change term and/or level by selecting from the lists and click the 'Select' button. Then search for classes below.

CRAO - Older Adults, Creative Art

CRAO NC101 - Beginning Oil Painting: For Older Adults (0 Unit)

Basic of painting skills are explored through practice and demonstration for the older adult. Seeks to coordinate the creative process with the fundamental skill set necessary to make successful paintings. Special emphasis is placed on the social interaction and critical thinking aspects inherent in group studio arts classes. Frequent review of new concepts occur through lectures and demonstrations. The pace of demonstrations and lectures are suited to the needs and abilities of individual student. Peer critique is utilized to maximize social interaction and encourage problem solving.
